The Residential program at Haven of Rest Ministries gives men a chance to change their lives by addressing challenges that have caused them to be caught in the cycle of homelessness. Whether it is drug abuse, unemployment, or other issues, Haven of Rest offers them hope through Christ. They are able to transform their lives and begin again. This transformation is not only in the form of employment, sobriety, and permanent housing, but also includes spiritual transformation through Jesus Christ.

Three men - Randy, Brent, and Phil – experienced transformation when they made public confessions of their faith in Christ and were baptized in November of 2020 at a local church. We rejoice with them as they profess to have found forgiveness in the Lord as well as forgiving those who have hurt them and contributed to their suffering, addiction, and guilt in their lives. To them, baptism signifies a new life in Christ as they shed the old one. They expressed joy as they look forward to what the Lord has in store for them.

Two more men - Justin and Josh - were also baptized in late February. As many of us know from experience, Christ brings so many changes to our lives for the good. He renews, restores, and rejuvenates throughout periods in our lives. Baptism signifies one of those moments. Many guests who come to the Mission seek to find healing from past trauma and abuse. One of the ways is through baptism, where they have the opportunity to release everything and feel freedom from a difficult past. We celebrate with our guests who publicly profess new beginnings!
