"My new freedom felt good," says Michael. "I partied on weekends and used drugs all through my college years."



UNRAVELING

Michael wandered further and further down a path of destruction. He began profiting off of growing marijuana in his own home. "What started as a recreational grow lab turned into a big business that got me in trouble," he says. Michael found himself facing charges and probation.

By the time Michael was off probation, homelessness was becoming a harsh reality. "Addiction made it so hard for me to keep a job," he says. "I wasn't paying my mortgage and eventually lost my house." The dream

life that Michael had built was completely unraveling.

For a year, Michael stayed at friends' houses, on he wa couches, in abandoned vehicles, and on park benches. His dad tried to help him get back on track, but meetin Michael burned every bridge. He realized the solid homel foundation he had growing up was gone.

"Haven of Rest provided a safe place of refuge for me where I could look at my life from a biblical perspective," says Michael. "I came here with only a backpack. Now look at my life!"
