"Hectic. Stressful. Toxic."

That's how Amy describes her life before the Mission.

"I was a functional alcoholic until I just couldn't function anymore," she says. Amy loved her job, but the environment and the people encouraged a cycle of overworking and overdrinking.

Secretly battling an addiction while trying to fulfill the demands of her job took a toll on Amy. Eventually, it all became too much to bear. She reached her breaking point.

"I walked away from my life and didn't have a place to stay," says Amy. "I left behind all of the people, my apartment and everything in it. I only had the clothes on my back and left everything else. I didn't know what to do."

Out of options and out of hope, Amy cried out to God, "I can't do this anymore." He brought her to Harvest Home in her time of need.
