Then, something unexpected happened—as he was scrolling through social media on his phone, Bible verses kept popping up.


"Every time I would read them, I would feel better about things," he says. "Deep down, inside, I wanted to build a foundation — something for the future to hang on to."

That led him to search for Christian addiction programs.


You gave Chris a place to begin again
